Getting a License for your Wedding Video

Applications for a video license for a wedding is now available from the Performing Rights Society (PRS for Music).

The license required is to make physical copies of the wedding (typically DVDs), and not to actually do the video recording. It is known as "Limited Manufacture" license. In order to ensure that the legalities are correct, we need to know that the correct license has been obtained, either by you or your video-er.

The license needed depends on two things : Firstly whether any recorded music (eg off a CD) is used in the service and included on the DVD; and secondly, how many DVDs you intend to make.

This table comes from the PRS website, and gives the costs. If the music on the DVD is live only (organ, choir etc) then you need the "MCPS Only Rates" column. If the DVD includes the playing of recorded music, then its the "MCPS-PPL Joint Rates" column.

A wedding will normally have < (less than) 25 minutes of music in it.

So, for example, if your wedding has just organ and sung music, and you plan to make say, 20 copies, the license will cost £20.42.

You'll need to register with your e-mail address and make up a password. That's so that your license can be e-mailed to you.
